Campus Candidate Debate Rules

All the candidates who are contesting the SBSC students' union election for the year 2024-25 are required to attend the Campus Candidate debate as per the following schedule.

Venue: Open Air Auditorium, SBSC

Date: 23rd September 2024

Time: 11 AM

- 1. Each candidate will be strictly limited to 5 (Five) minutes for their speech. A warning bell will ring at the 4th minute. The candidate is then expected to conclude his/her speech in the next one minute.
- 2. The order of speech of the candidates will be decided in accordance to the post applied for and in alphabetical order.
- 3. A total of three legitimate questions can be asked from a candidate by the audience either in English or Hindi. Audience is requested to mention the name of the candidate to whom the question is addressed.
- 4. Candidates are encouraged to support their claims with evidence, facts, or examples. The Students' Union and Welfare Committee is not responsible for any factual error in the text of question or answer by the candidate.
- 5. The Students' Union and Welfare Committee reserves the right to reject any question.
- 6. The speakers are requested to refrain from personal slanders in their speech.
- 7. There shall be no appeal to caste or communal feelings.
- 8. The audience must respect the speakers and their viewpoints. The Audience is expected to refrain from indulging in any unnecessary sloganeering, booing and raising of any uncivil slogans.
- 9. The Election Committee will be responsible for making final decisions regarding any disputes or violations of the rules.
- 10. The candidates or students are requested not to distribute printed pamphlets.
- 11. Any violation of above-mentioned rules and the Lyngdoh Committee guidelines by the candidate may lead to cancellation of their candidature.
